✤ <u>Educational Programme</u>

- I(One) Eklavya Model Day Boarding School (EMDBS) for Killa R.D. Block under Gomati District has been sanctioned during 2018-19. The EMDBS, Killa has been made functional in Dasarath Deb Memorial English Medium High School, Killa from the academic session 2019-20.
- A Tribal Rest House has been inaugurated and made functional at Kailashahar.
- 200 seated community hall namely "NOYUNGMA" has been constructed at Khejurbagan, Agartala.

✤ <u>Support for Income Generation Activities.</u>

- During the year 2018-19, total 1,672 nos. ST beneficiaries have been benefitted for various income generating schemes like Rubber plantation, Bamboo plantation, ARDD Activities (Piggery, Goatery & Poultry), Horti activities (Pineapple, Arecanut, Banana) under SCA to TSS.
- During 2018-19, Skill Development training has been provided to 586 nos. ST Youths.
- Soft loans have been provided to 299 nos. ST youths from ST Corporation for self-employed economic activities viz. small business, transport business and Agri & Allied etc. Education loan have been provided to 21 nos. ST students for pursuing higher studies from ST Corporation during 2018-19.
