Functions of the District Level Committee

The District Level Committee shall-

- i) Ensure that the requisite information under clause (b) of Rule-6 has been provided to Gram Sabha or Forest Rights Committee;
- j) Examine whether all claims, especially those of Primitive Tribal Groups, Pastoralists and Nomadic Tribes have been addressed keeping in mind the objectives of Act;
- k) Consider and finally approve the claims and record of Forest Rights prepared by the Sub-Divisional Level Committee;
- Hear petitions from persons aggrieved by the orders of the Sub-Divisional Level Committee;
- m) Co-ordinate with other Districts regarding inter-district claims;
- n) Issue directions from incorporation of the Forest Rights in the relevant Government records including record of Rights;
- o) Ensure publication of the records of Forest Rights as may be finalized; and
- p) Ensure that a certified copy of the record of Forest Rights and title under the Act, as specified in Annexure-II & III to these rules, is provided to the concerned claimant and the Gram Sabha respectively.

This will come into force with immediate effect. This is issued in supersession of the memo No.F.11-174(P)/TW/FRC/2014-(Vol-III)/24389-449, dated, 15th November, 2015.
