MEMORANDUM

The guidelines of the scheme namely "Special Coaching in core Subject" for the Sch. Tribe Students of Class VIII to X at Pre-Madhyamik stage and XI-XII for Post-Madhyamik stage for proper implementation of the scheme has been revised as follows:-

1. Intake capacity for each coaching center:

i) Pre- Madhyamik:-

- a. Coaching classes shall be combined for ST students of class VI X & XI XII and all the eligible boarders / day scholars shall be enrolled in such coaching classes.
- b. For each subject there shall be separate coaching classes:
- c. In each coaching center, minimum 40 (Forty) students and the maximum 50 (Fifty) students shall be enrolled. There shall not be a second center, if the first one does not exceed 50 strength, for opening of second centre separate approval is required from the Tribal Welfare

ii) Post Madhyamik:-

- a. Coaching classes shall be combined for ST students of class XI & XII
- b. For each subject, there shall be separate coaching classes
- c. In each coaching centre, minimum 40 (forty) students and the maximum 50 (fifty) students shall be enrolled, there shall not be a second centre
- · separate approval will be required from the Tribal Welfare Department

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2. Duration of special coaching center:-

a. Special coaching class shall be engaged for period of 5 (Five) month in an academic year.

b. Duration of each coaching classes shall be 60 minutes per tutor per subject.

3. Number of tutors and staff to be engaged:-

- a. For imparting separate coaching classes for ST Students of class IX to X, 5 (five) tutors will be engaged for science, mathematics, English, Bengali and Geography subject.
- b. For imparting separate coaching classes for ST Students of class XI to XII, 4 (four) tutors will be engaged for science, mathematics, English, and Bengali subject.
- c. For imparting separate coaching in core subject for ST students of class XI & XII, 4 (four) tutors shall be engaged as follows: Science stream student of XI-XII a) Physics b) Chemistry Delology d) Mathematics (any three of the elective subjects) and one English language is compulsory for each Science students.
- d. A teacher shall take at least 3 (three) classes in a day and that may be in two spells or whichever is convenient.
- e. The respective Headmaster / Headmistress or any teacher nominated by the Headmaster / Headmistress of the school will be engaged as In-Charge of the Coaching center who will be fully responsible for proper functioning of the center, in case of the boarding houses.
- Minimum qualification of teaching staff should be graduate in Science / English subject.
- g. For each coaching center, one helper will be engaged to assist the Incharge

4. Financial component:-

a. Each teacher engaged for imparting coaching of student from class VI to X shall be given the tutor fees @ Rs. 3,000/- per month per teacher.

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- b. Each teacher engaged for imparting coaching of student from class XI to XII shall be given the tutor fees @ Rs. 3,000/- per month.
- c. In charge of the center shall be paid @ Rs. 300/- per month in case of Govt. Organization and Rs. 1500/- to a NGO per month as honorarium
- d. The helper shall be entitled of wages @ Rs. 500/- per month in case of NGO and honorarium shall be paid to a Class IV staff @ Rs. 200/- per month, if Govt. employee is engaged.
- e. Contingency shall be paid @ Rs. 300/- per month to each coaching centre run by govt. Institutions / NGOs.

5. Mode of implementation:-

- a. The candidate from interior Tribal Areas / BPL shall get preference in admission at such coaching centre.
- b. Special coaching centre shall be allowed preferable in Block Head quarter and shall not be encouraged under Sadar Sub- Division where private teacher available.
- c. One NGO may open one centre in a Sub- Division. No Second centre will be allowed for same NGO to conduct coaching in the same Sub-Division.
- d. Any reputed Voluntary organization may also be entrusted to run special coaching center approved by the District Magistrate & Collector of the concerned District.
- e. The District Welfare Officer and Sub-Divisional Welfare Officer respectively shall be responsible for overall supervision and monitoring of the scheme.

This will take effect from the financial year 2012-13.
