MEETING NOTICE

One day Workshop-cum-Sensitisation programme on various Scholarship Schemes for ST students being implemented in the State through National Scholarship Portal (NSP) and Beneficiary Management Ecosystem (BMS) is scheduled to be held on <u>31st August, 2024</u> at <u>11:00 AM</u> in the Conference Hall of the Directorate of Tribal Welfare, Govt. of Tripura, P.N. Complex, Gurkhabasti, Agartala.

2. Details of the scholarship schemes for ST students under NSP and BMS viz. **objective of the scheme, criteria for selection, required documents, financial benefits, online application procedure, verification process, calendar/timelines of NSP/BMS for AY/FY 2024-25** shall be discussed in details in the aforementioned programme for wide dissemination of information.

3. Guidelines for availing "Post-Matric Scholarship/Pre-Matric scholarship to ST students" under Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA), Govt. of India with a special reference to <u>AADHAR Linked One</u> <u>Time Registration (OTR) in NSP</u> shall be discussed in the aforesaid sensitisation programme. As per communication of MoTA vide letter No.F.19012/07/2023-Sch, dated 1st July, 2024, **OTR is mandatory for availing Post-Matric and Pre-Matric scholarship through National scholarship Portal (NSP) from the AY/FY 2024-25**.

4. One Time Registration (OTR) is a **unique 14-digit number** issued based on the AADHAR/ AADHAR Enrolment ID (EID) to streamline the registration process and is applicable for the entire academic career of the student. The students who have applied on NSP in AY/FY 2024-25 will be allotted the OTR/Reference number through the portal and intimated through SMS. This unique number allows users to log in and access various services without needing to re-register and also **simplify the registration process and ensure deduplication, which will prevent fraudulent cases.** As per recommendations of the **Task Force** constituted for '**Strengthening of National Scholarship**' approved by the **Committee of Secretaries (CoS)**, the NSP will **open in June and close in October. Extension in timelines regarding application submission in NSP is not possible beyond the recommendations of the CoS**.

5. The **President/Secretary/General Secretary** of various ST Student's Organisation of Tripura are hereby requested to attend or nominate **maximum 3 (three)** members in the aforesaid Workshop-cum-Sensitisation programme on the aforementioned **date, time and venue** for smooth implementation of the schemes onboarded in NSP and BMS.
